4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 32.111(c), Election Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(c) The training standards adopted under Subsection (a)
8	must:
9	(1) include provisions on the acceptance and handling
10	of the identification presented by a voter to an election officer
11	under Section 63.001; and
12	(2) detail the types of driver's licenses that are
13	acceptable forms of identification under Section 63.0101 and
14	require that training materials include a photograph of a limited
15	term license issued under Subchapter L-1, Chapter 521,
16	Transportation Code.
17	SECTION 2. Chapter 521, Transportation Code, is amended by
18	adding Subchapter L-1 to read as follows:
19	SUBCHAPTER L-1. LIMITED TERM LICENSE
20	Sec. 521.261. LIMITED TERM LICENSE. (a) A limited term
21	license is a driver's license issued by the department with an
22	expiration date set under Section 521.271(a-2), (a-3), or (a-4),
23	521.2711(c), or 521.272(c)(2), Transportation Code.
24	(b) Each limited term license must comply with the

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1	requirements of this subchapter.
2	(c) Except as otherwise provided by this subchapter, a
3	reference in this subchapter to a limited term license includes a
4	limited term instruction permit.
5	Sec. 521.262. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. (a) A limited
6	term license:
7	(1) is not valid as proof of the license holder's
8	identity for a federal purpose;
9	(2) is not an acceptable form of identification under
10	Section 63.0101, Election Code, for voting purposes; and
11	(3) expires in the manner provided by Subchapter M.
12	(b) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter:
13	(1) a person who holds a limited term license is
14	subject to the laws of this state applicable to the holder of a
15	driver's license;
16	(2) a person who holds a limited term provisional
17	license or instruction permit is subject to the laws of this state
18	applicable to a holder of a provisional license or instruction
19	permit; and
20	(3) a person who holds a limited term occupational
21	license is subject to the laws of this state applicable to the
22	holder of an occupational license.
23	Sec. 521.263. LIMITED TERM LICENSE APPEARANCE. The
24	department shall:
25	(1) adopt rules regarding the design and content of a
26	limited term license;
27	(2) designate and clearly mark as a limited term

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1 license a license described by Section 521.261(a); 2 (3) orient the information on and design the color of a limited term license to clearly distinguish the limited term 3 license from other licenses issued under this chapter; and 4 5 (4) include on a limited term license an indication that the license is not valid proof of identity for a federal 6 7 purpose or for voting purposes. 8 Sec. 521.264. APPLICATION. (a) The department may require each applicant for a limited term license to furnish to the 9 10 department the information required by Section 521.142. (b) An application for a limited term license: 11 12 (1) must include a complete set of thumbprints and fingerprints; and 13 14 (2) must include documentation issued by the 15 appropriate United States agency that authorizes the applicant to be in the United States but may not use as proof of the applicant's 16 17 residency status or lawful status: 18 (A) an employment authorization document issued 19 through the federal Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program; 20 or 21 (B) a reentry permit. 22 (c) Information supplied to the department relating to an applicant's medical history is for the confidential use of the 23 24 department and may not be disclosed to any person or used as evidence in a legal proceeding other than a proceeding under 25 26 Subchapter N. 27 (d) The application must provide space for the applicant to

1 voluntarily list any health condition that may impede communication with a peace officer as evidenced by a written statement from a 2 3 licensed physician. 4 Sec. 521.265. EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY 5 REQUIRED. (a) An application for a limited term license must be 6 accompanied by: 7 (1) evidence of financial responsibility that 8 complies with Section 521.143 and this section; or 9 (2) a statement that the applicant does not own a motor vehicle for which evidence of financial responsibility is required 10 11 under Chapter 601. 12 (b) An applicant for a limited term license that provides evidence of financial responsibility must establish financial 13 14 responsibility through a motor vehicle liability insurance policy 15 that complies with Chapter 601 and is prepaid and valid for at least a six-month period after the date the person submits the 16 17 application. Sec. 521.266. ADMINISTRATION. The department is not 18 19 required to issue limited term licenses at all driver's license offices. The department may designate driver's license offices to 20 issue limited term licenses. 21

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
