1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of Westside Drive in El Paso County as
 1-20 the Don Juan de Onate Trail.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 442, Government Code, is
 1-23 amended by adding Section 442.030 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 442.030. DON JUAN DE ONATE TRAIL AS TEXAS HISTORIC
 1-25 HIGHWAY. (a) The commission shall cooperate with the Texas
 1-26 Department of Transportation to designate, interpret, and market
 1-27 Westside Drive in El Paso County as the Don Juan de Onate Trail and a
 1-28 Texas historic highway.

1-29 (b) To supplement revenue available for the purposes under
 1-30 Subsection (a), the commission and the Texas Department of
 1-31 Transportation may pursue federal funds dedicated to highway
 1-32 enhancement.

1-33 (c) A designation of Westside Drive in El Paso County as the
 1-34 Don Juan de Onate Trail and a Texas historic highway may not be
 1-35 construed as a designation under the National Historic Preservation
 1-36 Act (16 U.S.C. Section 470 et seq.).

1-37 (d) The Texas Department of Transportation is not required
 1-38 to design, construct, or erect a marker under this section unless a
 1-39 grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the
 1-40 cost of the design, construction, and erection of the marker. Money
 1-41 received to cover the cost of the marker shall be deposited to the
 1-42 credit of the state highway fund.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
