## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the donation of juror reimbursements. 1-18 1-19

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 61.003(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-21

1-22 1-23 (a) Each person who reports for jury service shall be personally provided a form letter that when signed by the person 1-24 directs the county treasurer to donate all, or a specific amount 1-25 designated by the person, of the person's daily reimbursement under 1-26 this chapter to:

1-27 1-28 (1)the compensation to victims of crime fund under Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal Procedure; (2) the child welfare, child protective services, or

1-32 (3) any program selected by the commissioners court that is operated by a public or private nonprofit organization and that provides shelter and services to victims of family violence; 1-33 1-34 1-35 [<del>or</del>]

(4) any other program approved by the commissioners court of the county, including a program established under Article 56.04(f), Code of Criminal Procedure, that offers psychological counseling to jurors in criminal cases involving graphic evidence 1-36 1-37 1-38 1-39 or testimony<u>; or</u> 1-40
