A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the funding, issuing, and litigation of certain
- 3 marriage licenses.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Preservation of
- 6 Sovereignty and Marriage Act.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 2.001, Family Code, is amended to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (c) State or local funds may not be used for an activity that
- 10 <u>includes the licensing or support of a same-sex marriage.</u>
- 11 (d) A state or local governmental employee may not
- 12 recognize, grant, or enforce a same-sex marriage license.
- (e) State or local funds may not be used to enforce an order
- 14 requiring the issuance or recognition of a same-sex marriage
- 15 license.
- SECTION 3. Sec. 118.022, Local Government Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 (a) If the county clerk collects a fee for issuing a
- 19 marriage license, the county clerk shall remit monthly to the
- 20 Comptroller any amount collected for the application of a marriage
- 21 license [$\frac{\text{deposit}}{\text{deposit}}$], as provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 133[\div].
- 22 (1) \$20 of each fee collected for issuing a marriage
- 23 license or \$12.50 of each fee for recording a declaration of
- 24 informal marriage shall be [to be sent to the comptroller and]

- 1 deposited as provided by Subsection (b);
- 2 (2) \$10 of each fee collected for issuing a marriage
- 3 license $\underline{\text{shall be}}$ [to be sent to the comptroller and] deposited as
- 4 provided by Subsection (c); and
- 5 (3) if applicable, the \$5 voluntary contribution
- 6 collected to promote healthy early childhood by supporting the
- 7 Texas Home Visiting Program administered by the Office of Early
- 8 Childhood Coordination of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 9 shall be [to be sent to the comptroller and] deposited as provided
- 10 by Subsection (d).
- 11 (b) The comptroller shall deposit the money received under
- 12 Subsection (a)(1) to the credit of the child abuse and neglect
- 13 prevention trust fund account established under Section 40.105,
- 14 Human Resources Code.
- 15 (c) The comptroller shall deposit the money received under
- 16 Subsection (a)(2) to the credit of the family trust fund account
- 17 established under Section 2.014, Family Code.
- 18 (d) The comptroller shall deposit the money received under
- 19 Subsection (a)(3) in the Texas Home Visiting Program trust fund
- 20 under Section 531.287, Government Code.
- 21 <u>(e) The Comptroller shall return any remaining fees</u>
- 22 collected in compliance with Family Code 2.001(b). Any fees that
- 23 cannot be returned shall be deposited to General Revenue.
- 24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
