BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 36.002, Water Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as 1-20 1-21 1-22 1-23 follows:

(b) The groundwater ownership and rights described by this 1-24 section[+

1-25 [(1)] entitle the landowner, including a landowner's 1-26

lessees, heirs, or assigns, to: (1) drill for and produce the groundwater below the surface of real property, subject to Subsection (d), without causing waste or malicious drainage of other property or 1-27 1-28 1-29 1-30 negligently causing subsidence; and

(2) have any other right recognized under common law. -1) The groundwater ownership and rights described by 1-31 1-32 1-33 this section do [, but does] not:

(1) entitle a landowner, including a landowner's lessees, heirs, or assigns, to the right to capture a specific amount of groundwater below the surface of that landowner's land; 1-34 1-35 1-36 or [and] 1-37

1-38 [do not] affect the existence of common law (2) 1-39 defenses or other defenses to liability under the rule of capture.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-40 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-41 1-42 1-43 1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
