 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to the board of directors of the Fulshear Town Center
 1-19 Management District.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. (a) On the effective date of this Act, the board
 1-22 of directors of the Fulshear Town Center Management District
 1-23 established under Chapter 3903, Special District Local Laws Code,
 1-24 is dissolved.

1-25 (b) On the effective date of this Act, the board of
 1-26 directors of the Fulshear Town Center Management District is
 1-27 reconstituted and is composed of the following directors:

1-34 (c) The terms of the directors appointed under Subsection
 1-35 (b) of this section expire June 1, 2016.

1-36 (d) Of the directors who replace a director appointed under
 1-37 Subsection (b) of this section, the terms of directors serving in
 1-38 positions 1, 2, and 3 expire June 1, 2018, and the terms of
 1-39 directors serving in positions 4 and 5 expire June 1, 2020.

1-40 (e) Section 3903.052, Special District Local Laws Code,
 1-41 does not apply to this section.

1-42 SECTION 2. Section 3903.061, Special District Local Laws
 1-43 Code, is repealed.

1-44 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
 1-45 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
 1-46 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
 1-47 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
 1-48 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
 1-49 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
 1-50 Government Code.

1-51 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
 1-52 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
 1-53 Environmental Quality.

1-54 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
 1-55 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
 1-56 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
 1-57 representatives within the required time.

1-58 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
 1-59 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
 1-60 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
 1-61 and accomplished.

2-1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-5 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
