1-16 WHEREAS, In the new world of social media, people of every age
1-17 and background from around the world may take part in an endless
1-18 conversation about all facets of the Lone Star State by using the
1-19 hashtag #Texas; and

1-20 WHEREAS, In a dynamic, ever-changing stream that runs 24
1-21 hours a day, seven days a week, users of Twitter and other online
1-22 platforms anywhere on the globe may use #Texas to see what people
1-23 are saying about Texas and to address other followers of the hashtag
1-24 on anything and everything pertaining to our great state; and

1-25 WHEREAS, At any given moment, this unfiltered discussion can
1-26 range from serious political discussions to wisecracks, from
1-27 advertising to comments about the heat in Houston, from complaints
1-28 and praise about Texas sporting franchises to celebrations of Texas
1-29 writers, artists, and musicians; and

1-30 WHEREAS, Social media is transforming the way people the
1-31 world over share their beliefs, ideals, wit, and fancies, and the
1-32 followers of #Texas are provided with an always fascinating and
1-33 never-ending parade of what people talk about when they talk about
1-34 Texas; now, therefore, be it

1-35 RESOLVED, That the 84th Legislature of the State of Texas
1-36 hereby designate #Texas as the official hashtag of the state of
1-37 Texas.

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
