HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-16 WHEREAS, The framers of the Constitution established the 1-17 United States as a representative democracy that relies on civic 1-18 engagement; and

1-19 WHEREAS, A fundamental element of effective democracy is the 1-20 principle that all eligible citizens should participate in fair and 1-21 open elections; however, the Rio Grande Valley has historically low 1-22 voter turnout; and 1-23 WHEREAS, Rio Grande Valley residents increased their

1-23 WHEREAS, Rio Grande Valley residents increased their 1-24 registration rates by 72 percent between 2010 and 2014; 1-25 nevertheless, only about 24 percent of registered voters cast a 1-26 ballot in the 2014 mid-term election; and

1-27 WHEREAS, In order to reach those who have not fully embraced 1-28 their rights and responsibilities as citizens, the community must 1-29 expand opportunities for voter education and nonpartisan voter 1-30 registration; vital contributions in this regard can be made by 1-31 grassroots organizations, by the media, by educational, cultural, 1-32 and religious institutions, and by other entities in both the 1-33 public and private sector; and

1-34 WHEREAS, Across the Rio Grande Valley, there is an urgent 1-35 need to increase participation in the electoral process; now, 1-36 therefore, be it

1-37 RESOLVED, That the 84th Legislature of the State of Texas 1-38 hereby designate September as Valley Voter Awareness Month; and, be 1-39 it further

1-40 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 1-41 391.004(d), Government Code, this designation remain in effect 1-42 until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally 1-43 passed by the legislature.
