- 10 medicine in 1963; that same year, he embarked on his medical career
- 11 as an intern at Dallas Methodist Hospital, and in 1964, he began his
- 12 residency at Parkland Memorial Hospital; he joined the
- 13 Anesthesiology Association of Arlington in 1967 and received his
- 14 board certification in 1970; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Morris returned to Parkland in 1972 as an
- 16 associate professor and as the burn unit's head of anesthesiology;
- 17 the following year, he joined the staff of Dallas Children's
- 18 Hospital, where he served as head of anesthesiology for the next 11
- 19 years; in 1984, he returned to private practice with the
- 20 Anesthesiology Association of Arlington, and he retired in 2007;

- WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Dr. Morris enjoyed the love
- 23 and support of his wife, Ann, and of his three daughters; and
