1-19 relating to a report concerning information security for this
1-20 state's information resources.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 2054.133, Government Code, is amended by
1-23 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

1-24 (f) Not later than January 13 of each odd-numbered year, the
1-25 department shall submit a written report to the governor, the
1-26 lieutenant governor, and the legislature evaluating information
1-27 security for this state's information resources. In preparing the
1-28 report, the department shall consider the information security
1-29 plans submitted by state agencies under this section, any
1-30 vulnerability reports submitted under Section 2054.077, and other
1-31 available information regarding the security of this state's
1-32 information resources. The department shall omit from any written
1-33 copies of the report information that could expose specific
1-34 vulnerabilities in the security of this state's information
1-35 resources.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
