1-19 relating to the acknowledgment by management of risks identified in  
 1-20 state agency information security plans.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 2054.133, Government Code, is amended by  
 1-23 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-24 (e) Each state agency shall include in the agency's  
 1-25 information security plan a written acknowledgment that the  
 1-26 executive director or other head of the state agency, the chief  
 1-27 financial officer, and each executive manager as designated by the  
 1-28 state agency have been made aware of the risks revealed during the  
 1-29 preparation of the agency's information security plan.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
