BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 25.2222(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-25

1-26 1-27 A county court at law in Tarrant County has jurisdiction (a) civil matters and causes, original and appellate, over all 1-28 prescribed by law for county courts. The County Court at Law No. 1 1-29 of Tarrant County also has jurisdiction over all criminal matters and causes, original and appellate, prescribed by law for county 1-30 courts. The County Courts at Law Nos. 2 and 3 of Tarrant County do not have criminal jurisdiction. <u>Notwithstanding any other</u> 1-31 1-32 provision, a county court at law in Tarrant County has jurisdiction 1-33 on any appeal from a municipal court of record in Tarrant County 1-34 that is not an appeal of a criminal law case or proceeding.
