1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the marketing and advertising of the veterans'
 1-20 assistance lottery game.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 466.027, Government Code, is amended by
 1-23 adding Subsections (d-1) and (f) and amending Subsection (e) to
 1-24 read as follows:

1-25 (d-1) The commission shall produce and place printed
 1-26 point-of-sale advertising materials promoting the lottery game
 1-27 operated under this section at each licensed location that provides
 1-28 appropriate, lottery-dedicated space to display the materials.

1-29 (e) The commission shall include on the commission's
 1-30 Internet website a dedicated page that:

1-31 (1) features the game operated under this section;

1-32 (2) provides information on the benefits provided to
 1-33 veterans through funding from the game; and

1-34 (3) is accessible by a prominent link on the main page
 1-35 of the commission's website.

1-36 (f) No organization that would otherwise be eligible to
 1-37 receive funds from the state lottery account attributable to any
 1-38 lottery game authorized by this section may receive any such funds
 1-39 if it conducts illegal gambling or the illegal operation of
 1-40 gambling devices as defined by Chapter 47, Penal Code, or allows
 1-41 illegal gambling or the illegal operation of gambling devices to be
 1-42 conducted on its property or in its facilities.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
