1-19 relating to continuation of an additional fee for filing civil
 1-20 cases in certain Dallas County courts.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Sections 51.705(f) and (h), Government Code, are
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (f) A resolution adopted under Subsection (e) continues
 1-25 from year to year until July 1, 2030 [~~2016~~], allowing the county to
 1-26 collect fees under the terms of this section until the resolution is
 1-27 rescinded.

1-28 (h) A fee established under a particular resolution is
 1-29 abolished on the earlier of:

1-30 (1) the date a resolution adopted under Subsection (e)
 1-31 is rescinded as provided by Subsection (g); or

1-32 (2) July 1, 2030 [~~2016~~].

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
