 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to a report made by the Texas Education Agency regarding
 1-24 the property and casualty insurance costs of school districts and
 1-25 open-enrollment charter schools.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
 1-28 amended by adding Section 44.905 to read as follows:

1-29 Sec. 44.905. PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE COSTS.

1-30 (a) Not later than December 1, 2016, the agency shall provide to
 1-31 the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the members of the
 1-32 legislature a report containing:

1-33 (1) the amount paid for property and casualty
 1-34 insurance per student in average daily attendance by each school
 1-35 district and open-enrollment charter school; and

1-36 (2) the statewide average amount paid by school
 1-37 districts and open-enrollment charter schools for property and
 1-38 casualty insurance per student in average daily attendance.

1-39 (b) This section expires September 1, 2017.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
