1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the compensation of county auditors for certain
 1-18 counties.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 152.032(d), Local Government Code, is
 1-21 amended to read as follows:

1-22 (d) The amount of the compensation and allowances of a
 1-23 county auditor in a county subject to this subsection may be set in
 1-24 an amount that exceeds the limit established by Subsection (a) if
 1-25 the compensation and allowances are approved by the commissioners
 1-26 court of the county. This subsection applies only to:

1-27 (1) a county with a population of more than 108,000 and
 1-28 less than 110,000;

1-29 (2) a county with a population of 120,000 or more,
 1-30 excluding a county subject to Subsection (b);

1-31 (3) a county with a population of more than 1,000 and
 1-32 less than 23,000 that borders the Gulf of Mexico; and

1-33 (4) a county that:

1-34 (A) borders a county with a population of more
 1-35 than one million; [subject to Subsection (b)] and

1-36 (B) [that] has a population of more than 36,000
 1-37 [108,000] and less than 40,000 [110,000].

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
