1-19 relating to the applicability of canceling an annual application  
 1-20 for a ballot to be voted by mail to subsequent elections.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 84, Election Code, is  
 1-23 amended by adding Section 84.038 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 84.038. CANCELLATION EFFECTIVE FOR SINGLE ELECTION FOR  
 1-25 CERTAIN VOTERS. The cancellation of an application for a ballot to  
 1-26 be voted by mail under Section 84.032(c), (d), or (e) does not  
 1-27 cancel the application with respect to a subsequent election to  
 1-28 which the same application applies under Section 86.0015(b).

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
