relating to the provision of a candidate's campaign mailing address and electronic mail address in the candidate's application for a place on the ballot.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 141.031(a), Election Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (a) A candidate's application for a place on the ballot that is required by this code must:
 - (1)be in writing;
