1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the amount that may be donated by contract by certain
1-20 populous counties to crime stoppers or crime prevention
1-21 organizations.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 351.901(b), Local Government Code, is
1-24 amended to read as follows:

1-25 (b) The commissioners court of a county by contract may
1-26 donate money to one or more crime stoppers or crime prevention
1-27 organizations for expenditure by the organizations to meet the
1-28 goals identified in Subsection (a). The total amount of all
1-29 donations made in a calendar year may not exceed:

1-30 (1) \$25,000; or
1-31 (2) \$100,000, for a county with a population of one
1-32 million or more.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
