 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the territory of the Harris County Municipal Utility  
 1-18 District No. 465.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 465, Acts of the 79th  
 1-21 Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 2. The Harris County Municipal Utility District No.  
 1-23 465 [~~initially~~] includes all the territory contained in the  
 1-24 following area:

1-25 Being 320.794 acres of land located in the A. E. Spencer  
 1-26 Survey, Abstract 1365, and the W. B. Macomer Survey, Abstract 1528,  
 1-27 the L. Breeding Survey, Abstract 1468, and the C. Breeding Survey,  
 1-28 Abstract 1467, Harris County, Texas, being a portion of that  
 1-29 certain called 315.38 acre tract (Tract I) and the residue of that  
 1-30 certain called 19.768 acre tract (Tract III) by an instrument of  
 1-31 record in File Number D990282, Official Public Records of Real  
 1-32 Property, Harris County, Texas, (H.C.O.P.R.R.P.), said 320.794  
 1-33 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds as  
 1-34 follows, all bearings based upon the west line of said 315.38 acre  
 1-35 tract, and being north (called north);

1-36 BEGINNING on the common line of said W. B. Macomer Survey,  
 1-37 Abstract 1528, and the H. & T.C. Railroad Company Survey Section 87,  
 1-38 Abstract 455 of said Harris County, Texas, at its intersection with  
 1-39 the north right-of-way line of F. M. Highway 529, said point being  
 1-40 the southwest corner of said 315.38 acre tract;

 1-61 Abstract 1365, said point being the southwest corner of said

 2-31 south line of the C. Breeding Survey, Abstract 1467, same being the  
 2-32 lower north line of the L. Breeding Survey, Abstract 1468, being the  
 2-33 upper south line of the herein described tract and the south line of  
 2-34 said called 19.768 acre tract, same being the north line of said  
 2-35 adjoining called 1.00 acre tract, and along the north line of an  
 2-36 adjoining called 1.9578 acre tract described in deed recorded under  
 2-37 County Clerk's File Number T233387, Official Public Records of Real  
 2-38 Property, Harris County, Texas, the north line of an adjoining  
 2-39 called 13.9559 acre tract described in deed recorded under County  
 2-40 Clerk's File Number G594514, Official Public Records of Real  
 2-41 Property, Harris County, Texas, the north line of an adjoining  
 2-42 called 13.955 acre tract described in deed recorded under County  
 2-43 Clerk's File Number H415235, Official Public Records of Real  
 2-44 Property, Harris County, Texas, the north line of an adjoining  
 2-45 called 3.955 acre tract described in deed recorded under County  
 2-46 Clerk's File Number G067328, Official Public Records of Real  
 2-47 Property, Harris County, Texas, and the north line of an adjoining  
 2-48 called 10 acre tract described in deed recorded under County  
 2-49 Clerk's File Number D745445, Official Public Records of Real  
 2-50 Property, Harris County, Texas, the north line of an adjoining  
 2-51 called 10 acre tract described in deed recorded under County  
 2-52 Clerk's File Number H755391, Official Public Records of Real  
 2-53 Property, Harris County, Texas, the north line of an adjoining  
 2-54 called 10 acre tract described in deed recorded under County

3-68 SECTION 2. (a) The Harris County Municipal Utility  
 3-69 District No. 465 retains all rights, powers, privileges, authority,

4-1 duties, and functions that it had before the effective date of this  
4-2 Act.

4-3 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the Harris County  
4-4 Municipal Utility District No. 465 may continue to rely on any bond  
4-5 election held before the effective date of this Act.

4-6 SECTION 3. (a) Any act or proceeding of the district,  
4-7 including an election, not excepted by this section and taken  
4-8 before the effective date of this Act, is validated and confirmed in  
4-9 all respects.

4-10 (b) This section does not apply to:

4-11 (1) an act, proceeding, director, other official,  
4-12 bond, or other obligation the validity of which or of whom is the  
4-13 subject of litigation that is pending on the effective date of this  
4-14 Act; or

4-15 (2) an act or proceeding that, under a statute of this  
4-16 state or the United States, was a misdemeanor or felony at the time  
4-17 the act or proceeding occurred.

4-18 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to  
4-19 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this  
4-20 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a  
4-21 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,  
4-22 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished  
4-23 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,  
4-24 Government Code.

4-25 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has  
4-26 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on  
4-27 Environmental Quality.

4-28 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
4-29 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the  
4-30 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of  
4-31 representatives within the required time.

4-32 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
4-33 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
4-34 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
4-35 and accomplished.

4-36 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
