 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to the setback requirements for a junkyard or an
 1-19 automotive wrecking and salvage yard.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 396.022(a), Transportation Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:

1-23 (a) A junkyard or an automotive wrecking and salvage yard
 1-24 may not be located:

1-25 (1) within 50 feet of the right-of-way of a public
 1-26 street or ~~state highway;~~ ~~or~~

1-27 (2) within 50 feet of the nearest property line of a
 1-28 residence.

1-29 SECTION 2. Section 396.022(a), Transportation Code, as
 1-30 amended by this Act, applies only to a junkyard or an automotive
 1-31 wrecking and salvage yard that begins operating on or after the
 1-32 effective date of this Act. A junkyard or an automotive wrecking
 1-33 and salvage yard operating before the effective date of this Act is
 1-34 governed by the law applicable immediately before the effective
 1-35 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
 1-36 purpose.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
