1-21 relating to changing the name of the Medical Advisory Committee
 1-22 appointed by the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation to
 1-23 the Combative Sports Advisory Board and allowing the board to
 1-24 address a broader range of issues.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 2052.055, Occupations Code, is amended
 1-27 to read as follows:

1-28 Sec. 2052.055. COMBATIVE SPORTS [MEDICAL] ADVISORY BOARD
 1-29 [~~COMMITTEE~~]. (a) The presiding officer of the commission, with
 1-30 the commission's approval, may appoint a combative sports [medical]
 1-31 advisory board [committee] to advise the department concerning
 1-32 [health] issues relating to [for] combative sports events and
 1-33 [event] contestants.

1-34 (b) If the commission elects to appoint an advisory board
 1-35 [~~committee~~], the commission by rule shall establish:

1-36 (1) the number of board [committee] members;

1-37 (2) qualifications for appointment to the board
 1-38 [~~committee~~]; and

1-39 (3) the purpose and duties of the board [committee].

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
