1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to designating the fourth Saturday in July as National Day  
 1-18 of the Cowboy.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is  
 1-21 amended by adding Section 662.061 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 662.061. NATIONAL DAY OF THE COWBOY. (a) The fourth  
 1-23 Saturday in July of each year is National Day of the Cowboy in  
 1-24 recognition of the historic, cultural, and social contributions of  
 1-25 the cowboy.

1-26 (b) National Day of the Cowboy shall be regularly observed  
 1-27 by appropriate ceremonies and activities.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
