1-19 relating to access to criminal history record information by a  
 1-20 county tax assessor-collector.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 411, Government Code, is  
 1-23 amended by adding Section 411.14065 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 411.14065. ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD  
 1-25 INFORMATION: COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR. A county tax  
 1-26 assessor-collector is entitled to obtain from the department  
 1-27 criminal history record information maintained by the department  
 1-28 that relates to a person who is an applicant for a motor vehicle  
 1-29 title service license issued under Subchapter E, Chapter 520,  
 1-30 Transportation Code.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
