BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 81.001, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:

(3) "High-speed rail" means intercity passenger rail service that is reasonably expected to reach speeds of at least 110 miles per hour.
SECTION 2. Section 81.002, Transportation Code, is amended

to read as follows:

Sec. 81.002. APPLICABILITY. In this title, a reference to a railroad company means [includes]:

(1) a railroad <u>initially</u> incorporated before September 1, 2007, under former Title 112, Revised Statutes; or

(2) any other legal entity operating a railroad, including an entity organized under the Texas Business Corporation Act or the Texas Corporation Law provisions of the Business Organizations Code, that owns or leases:
