1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the eradication of Carrizo cane along the Rio Grande
1-18 River.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 201, Agriculture Code, is
1-21 amended by adding Section 201.0225 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 201.0225. CARRIZO CANE ERADICATION PROGRAM. The state
1-23 board shall develop and implement a program to eradicate Carrizo
1-24 cane along the Rio Grande River.

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
