1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to requirements for the issuance of a driver's license or
 1-20 personal identification certificate.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 521.044(a), Transportation Code, as
 1-23 amended by Chapters 1012 (H.B. 2512) and 1105 (H.B. 3787), Acts of
 1-24 the 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is reenacted and
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (a) Information provided on a driver's license or personal
 1-27 identification certificate application that relates to the
 1-28 applicant's social security number may be used only by the
 1-29 department or disclosed only to:

1-30 (1) the child support enforcement division of the
 1-31 attorney general's office;

1-32 (2) another state entity responsible for enforcing the
 1-33 payment of child support;

1-34 (3) the United States Selective Service System as
 1-35 provided by Section 521.147;

1-36 (4) the unclaimed property division of the
 1-37 comptroller's office; ~~or~~

1-38 (5) the Health and Human Services Commission;

1-39 (6) ~~(5)~~ the secretary of state for the purposes of
 1-40 voter registration or the administration of elections; or

1-41 (7) an agency of another state responsible for issuing
 1-42 driver's licenses or identification documents.

1-43 SECTION 2. Sections 521.044(b) and (e), Transportation
 1-44 Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-45 (b) The department shall enter an applicant's social
 1-46 security number in the department's electronic database but may not
 1-47 print the number on the applicant's driver's license or personal
 1-48 identification certificate.

1-49 (e) The department shall include in the department's
 1-50 legislative appropriations requests and budgets, in quarterly
 1-51 performance reports, and in audits of the department's local
 1-52 offices performance measures on the percentage of complete and
 1-53 correct social security numbers on driver's licenses and personal
 1-54 identification certificates.

1-55 SECTION 3. Section 521.101(f), Transportation Code, is
 1-56 amended to read as follows:

1-57 (f) A personal identification certificate:

1-58 (1) for an applicant who is a citizen, national, or
 1-59 legal permanent resident of the United States or a refugee or asylee
 1-60 lawfully admitted into the United States, ~~+~~

1-61 ~~(A)~~ expires on a date specified by the

2-1 department [~~if the applicant is younger than 60 years of age, or~~
2-2 [~~(B) does not expire if the applicant is 60 years~~
2-3 ~~of age or older~~]; or

2-4 (2) for an applicant not described by Subdivision (1),
2-5 expires on:

2-6 (A) the earlier of:
2-7 (i) a date specified by the department; or
2-8 (ii) the expiration date of the applicant's
2-9 authorized stay in the United States; or

2-10 (B) the first anniversary of the date of
2-11 issuance, if there is no definite expiration date for the
2-12 applicant's authorized stay in the United States.

2-13 SECTION 4. Section 521.142(g), Transportation Code, is
2-14 amended to read as follows:

2-15 (g) The department shall [~~may~~] require an applicant to
2-16 provide the applicant's social security number or proof that the
2-17 applicant is not eligible for a social security number [~~only for a~~
2-18 ~~purpose permitted by Section 521.044~~].

2-19 SECTION 5. Subchapter I, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
2-20 is amended by adding Section 521.183 to read as follows:

2-21 Sec. 521.183. SURRENDER OF DRIVER'S LICENSE OR PERSONAL
2-22 IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATE. (a) A person is not entitled to
2-23 receive a driver's license until the person surrenders to the
2-24 department each personal identification certificate in the
2-25 person's possession that was issued by this state.

2-26 (b) A person is not entitled to receive a personal
2-27 identification certificate until the person surrenders to the
2-28 department each driver's license in the person's possession that
2-29 was issued by this state.

2-30 SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
2-31 a driver's license or personal identification certificate for which
2-32 an application is submitted on or after the effective date of this
2-33 Act. A driver's license or personal identification certificate for
2-34 which an application was submitted before the effective date of
2-35 this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
2-36 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
2-37 that purpose.

2-38 SECTION 7. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
2-39 over another Act of the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015,
2-40 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
2-41 codes.

2-42 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
