A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 531.951(a), Government Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) This subchapter applies only to the final licensing,
- 7 listing, or registration decisions of a health and human services
- 8 agency with respect to a person under the law authorizing the agency
- 9 to regulate the following types of persons:
- 10 (1) a youth camp licensed under Chapter 141, Health
- 11 and Safety Code;
- 12 (2) a home and community support services agency
- 13 licensed under Chapter 142, Health and Safety Code;
- 14 (3) a hospital licensed under Chapter 241, Health and
- 15 Safety Code;
- 16 (4) an institution licensed under Chapter 242, Health
- 17 and Safety Code;
- 18 (5) an assisted living facility licensed under Chapter
- 19 247, Health and Safety Code;
- 20 (6) a special care facility licensed under Chapter
- 21 248, Health and Safety Code;
- 22 (7) an intermediate care facility licensed under
- 23 Chapter 252, Health and Safety Code;
- 24 (8) a chemical dependency treatment facility licensed

- 1 under Chapter 464, Health and Safety Code;
- 2 (9) a mental hospital or mental health facility
- 3 licensed under Chapter 577, Health and Safety Code;
- 4 (10) a child-care facility or child-placing agency
- 5 licensed under or a family home listed or registered under Chapter
- 6 42, Human Resources Code; or
- 7 (11) <u>a day activity and health services</u> [an adult
- 8 day-care] facility licensed under Chapter 103, Human Resources
- 9 Code.
- SECTION 2. Section 164.003(5), Health and Safety Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (5) "Mental health facility" means:
- 13 (A) a "mental health facility" as defined by
- 14 Section 571.003;
- 15 (B) a residential treatment facility, other than
- 16 a mental health facility, in which persons are treated for
- 17 emotional problems or disorders in a 24-hour supervised living
- 18 environment; and
- 19 (C) a day activity and health services [an adult
- 20 day-care facility or adult day health care] facility as defined by
- 21 Section 103.003, Human Resources Code.
- SECTION 3. Section 250.001(3), Health and Safety Code, as
- 23 amended by Chapters 605 (S.B. 944) and 1168 (S.B. 492), Acts of the
- 24 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is reenacted and amended
- 25 to read as follows:
- 26 (3) "Facility" means:
- 27 (A) a nursing home, custodial care home, or other

- 1 institution licensed by the Department of Aging and Disability
- 2 Services under Chapter 242;
- 3 (B) an assisted living facility licensed by the
- 4 Department of Aging and Disability Services under Chapter 247;
- 5 (C) a home and community support services agency
- 6 licensed under Chapter 142;
- 7 (D) a day activity and health services [an adult
- 8 day care] facility licensed by the Department of Aging and
- 9 Disability Services under Chapter 103, Human Resources Code;
- 10 (E) a facility for persons with mental
- 11 retardation licensed under Chapter 252;
- 12 (F) an adult foster care provider that contracts
- 13 with the Department of Aging and Disability Services;
- 14 (G) a facility that provides mental health
- 15 services and that is operated by or contracts with the Department of
- 16 State Health Services;
- 17 (H) a local mental health or mental retardation
- 18 authority designated under Section 533.035;
- 19 (I) a person exempt from licensing under Section
- 20 142.003(a)(19);
- 21 (J) a special care facility licensed by the
- 22 Department of State Health Services under Chapter 248; [ex]
- 23 (K) a mental health service unit of a hospital
- 24 licensed under Chapter 241; or
- (L) $\left[\frac{K}{K}\right]$ a prescribed pediatric extended care
- 26 center licensed by the Department of Aging and Disability Services
- 27 under Chapter 248A.

- 1 SECTION 4. The heading to Chapter 103, Human Resources
- 2 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 CHAPTER 103. DAY ACTIVITY AND HEALTH SERVICES [ADULT DAY CARE]
- 4 SECTION 5. Sections 103.001 and 103.002, Human Resources
- 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 103.001. PURPOSE. It is the purpose of this chapter to
- 7 establish programs of quality <u>day activity</u> and <u>health services</u>
- 8 [adult day care and day health care] that will enable elderly and
- 9 handicapped persons with medical or functional impairments to
- 10 maintain maximum independence and to prevent premature or
- 11 inappropriate institutionalization. It is the purpose of this
- 12 chapter to provide adequately regulated supervision for elderly and
- 13 handicapped persons while enabling them to remain in a family
- 14 environment and affording the family a measure of normality in its
- 15 daily activities. The legislature intends to provide for the
- 16 development of policies and programs that will:
- 17 (1) provide alternatives to institutionalization;
- 18 (2) establish facilities for day activity and health
- 19 services [adult day care and day health care] throughout the state
- 20 that offer services and are accessible to economically
- 21 disadvantaged persons; and
- 22 (3) prevent inappropriate institutionalization.
- Sec. 103.002. SHORT TITLE. This chapter may be cited as the
- 24 Day Activity and Health Services [Adult Day Care] Act.
- SECTION 6. Sections 103.003(1) and (2), Human Resources
- 26 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 27 (1) "Day activity and health services [Adult day-care]

- 1 facility" means a facility that provides services under a day
- 2 <u>activity</u> and health services [an adult day-care] program on a daily
- 3 or regular basis but not overnight to four or more elderly or
- 4 handicapped persons who are not related by blood, marriage, or
- 5 adoption to the owner of the facility.
- 6 (2) "Day activity and health services [Adult day-care]
- 7 program" means a structured, comprehensive program that is designed
- 8 to meet the needs of adults with functional impairments through an
- 9 individual plan of care by providing health, social, and related
- 10 support services in a protective setting.
- 11 SECTION 7. Section 103.0041(a), Human Resources Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) A person may not operate a day activity and health
- 14 services [an adult day-care] facility without a license issued
- 15 under this chapter.
- SECTION 8. Section 103.006(a), Human Resources Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The department shall issue a license to operate a day
- 19 activity and health services [an adult day-care] facility to a
- 20 person who has met the application requirements and received
- 21 approval after an on-site inspection.
- SECTION 9. Section 103.007(a), Human Resources Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) An applicant for a license to operate <u>a day activity and</u>
- 25 health services [an adult day-care] facility must file an
- 26 application on a form prescribed by the department together with a
- 27 license fee of \$50.

- 1 SECTION 10. Section 103.0075(a), Human Resources Code, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) The department by rule shall adopt a procedure under
- 4 which a person proposing to construct or modify a day activity and
- 5 health services [an adult day-care] facility may submit building
- 6 plans to the department for review for compliance with the
- 7 department's architectural requirements before beginning
- 8 construction or modification. In adopting the procedure, the
- 9 department shall set reasonable deadlines by which the department
- 10 must complete review of submitted plans.
- 11 SECTION 11. Section 103.0091(a), Human Resources Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The department may petition a district court for a
- 14 temporary restraining order to restrain a continuing violation of
- 15 the standards or licensing requirements provided under this chapter
- 16 if the department finds that the violation creates an immediate
- 17 threat to the health and safety of the <u>day activity</u> and <u>health</u>
- 18 services facility [adult day-care] residents.
- 19 SECTION 12. Section 103.0092(a), Human Resources Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) If the department finds <u>a day activity and health</u>
- 22 <u>services</u> [an adult day-care] facility operating in violation of the
- 23 standards prescribed by this chapter and the violations create an
- 24 immediate threat to the health and safety of a resident in the
- 25 facility, the department shall suspend the license or order
- 26 immediate closing of all or part of the facility.
- 27 SECTION 13. Section 103.011, Human Resources Code, is

- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 103.011. RIGHTS OF THE ELDERLY. (a) In addition to
- 3 other rights an individual attending a day activity and health
- 4 <u>services</u> [an adult day care] facility has as a citizen, an
- 5 individual who is 55 years of age or older has the rights prescribed
- 6 by Chapter 102 of this code.
- 7 (b) The department shall require each <u>day activity and</u>
- 8 <u>health services</u> [adult day care] facility to implement and enforce
- 9 the applicable provisions of Chapter 102 of this code.
- 10 SECTION 14. Section 103.012(a), Human Resources Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) The department may assess an administrative penalty
- 13 against a person who:
- 14 (1) violates this chapter, a rule, standard, or order
- 15 adopted under this chapter, or a term of a license issued under this
- 16 chapter;
- 17 (2) makes a false statement of a material fact that the
- 18 person knows or should know is false:
- 19 (A) on an application for issuance or renewal of
- 20 a license or in an attachment to the application; or
- 21 (B) with respect to a matter under investigation
- 22 by the department;
- 23 (3) refuses to allow a representative of the
- 24 department to inspect:
- 25 (A) a book, record, or file required to be
- 26 maintained by <u>a day activity and health services</u> [an adult
- 27 day-care] facility; or

- 1 (B) any portion of the premises of <u>a day activity</u>
- 2 <u>and health services</u> [an adult day-care] facility;
- 3 (4) wilfully interferes with the work of a
- 4 representative of the department or the enforcement of this
- 5 chapter;
- 6 (5) wilfully interferes with a representative of the
- 7 department preserving evidence of a violation of this chapter, a
- 8 rule, standard, or order adopted under this chapter, or a term of a
- 9 license issued under this chapter;
- 10 (6) fails to pay a penalty assessed under this chapter
- 11 not later than the 30th day after the date the assessment of the
- 12 penalty becomes final; or
- 13 (7) fails to notify the department of a change of
- 14 ownership before the effective date of the change of ownership.
- SECTION 15. Sections 103.013(a) and (c), Human Resources
- 16 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) The department may not collect an administrative
- 18 penalty from a day activity and health services [an adult day-care]
- 19 facility under Section 103.012 if, not later than the 45th day after
- 20 the date the facility receives notice under Section 103.014(c), the
- 21 facility corrects the violation.
- (c) A day activity and health services [An adult day-care]
- 23 facility that corrects a violation must maintain the correction.
- 24 If the facility fails to maintain the correction until at least the
- 25 first anniversary after the date the correction was made, the
- 26 department may assess and collect an administrative penalty for the
- 27 subsequent violation. An administrative penalty assessed under

- 1 this subsection is equal to three times the amount of the original
- 2 penalty assessed but not collected. The department is not required
- 3 to provide the facility with an opportunity under this section to
- 4 correct the subsequent violation.
- 5 SECTION 16. Sections 103.014(c) and (e), Human Resources
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The department shall give written notice of the report
- 8 to the person charged with the violation not later than the 10th day
- 9 after the date on which the report is issued. The notice must
- 10 include:
- 11 (1) a brief summary of the charges;
- 12 (2) a statement of the amount of penalty recommended;
- 13 (3) a statement of whether the violation is subject to
- 14 correction under Section 103.013 and, if the violation is subject
- 15 to correction under that section, a statement of:
- 16 (A) the date on which the <u>day activity and health</u>
- 17 services [adult day-care] facility must file a plan of correction
- 18 with the department that the department shall review and may
- 19 approve, if satisfactory; and
- 20 (B) the date on which the plan of correction must
- 21 be completed to avoid assessment of the penalty; and
- 22 (4) a statement that the person charged has a right to
- 23 a hearing on the occurrence of the violation, the amount of the
- 24 penalty, or both.
- 25 (e) If the violation is subject to correction under Section
- 26 103.013, the day activity and health services [adult day-care]
- 27 facility shall submit a plan of correction to the department for

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- 1 approval not later than the 10th day after the date on which the
- 2 notice under Subsection (c) is received.
- 3 SECTION 17. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 4 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 5 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 6 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 7 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
