1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the composition of the Texas Violent Gang Task Force.  
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-19 SECTION 1. Article 61.10(f), Code of Criminal Procedure, is  
1-20 amended to read as follows:  
1-21 (f) The task force shall consist of:  
1-22 (1) a representative of the Department of Public  
1-23 Safety designated by the director of that agency;  
1-24 (2) two representatives of the Texas Department of  
1-25 Criminal Justice, including a representative of the parole  
1-26 division, designated by the executive director of that agency;  
1-27 (3) a representative of the office of the inspector  
1-28 general of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice designated by  
1-29 the inspector general;  
1-30 (4) two representatives [~~a representative~~] of the  
1-31 Texas Juvenile Justice Department [~~Youth Commission~~] designated by  
1-32 the executive director of that agency;  
1-33 (5) [~~a representative of the Texas Juvenile Probation~~  
1-34 ~~Commission designated by the executive director of that agency,~~  
1-35 ~~(6)~~] a representative of the office of the attorney  
1-36 general designated by the attorney general;  
1-37 (6) [(7)] six representatives who are local law  
1-38 enforcement officers or local community supervision personnel,  
1-39 including juvenile probation personnel, designated by the  
1-40 governor; ~~and~~  
1-41 (7) [(8)] two representatives who are local  
1-42 prosecutors designated by the governor; and  
1-43 (8) a representative of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage  
1-44 Commission designated by the executive director of that agency.  
1-45 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-46 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-47 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-48 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-49 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
