1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the annexation and eminent domain powers of and the
 1-18 development of certain wastewater projects by the Needmore Ranch
 1-19 Municipal Utility District No. 1.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Sections 8471.104 and 8471.105, Special District
 1-22 Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 8471.104. ~~NO [LIMITATION ON USE OF] EMINENT DOMAIN~~
 1-24 ~~POWER. [(a)] The district may not exercise the power of eminent~~
 1-25 ~~domain [except for the purpose of importing surface water or~~
 1-26 ~~nonlocal groundwater into the district.~~

1-27 ~~[(b) For purposes of this section, nonlocal groundwater~~
 1-28 ~~includes only groundwater that is withdrawn from a source outside~~
 1-29 ~~the Edwards Aquifer and the Trinity Aquifer].~~

1-30 Sec. 8471.105. LIMITATION ON ANNEXATION. The district may
 1-31 not add land by petition of less than all the landowners under
 1-32 Section 49.302, Water Code[, unless the petition required under
 1-33 that section is signed by the owners of a two-thirds majority of the
 1-34 assessed value of the land in the defined area described by the
 1-35 petition].

1-36 SECTION 2. Section 8471.103(c), Special District Local Laws
 1-37 Code, is repealed.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015, but only
 1-39 if H.B. 3405, S.B. 1440, or similar legislation of the 84th
 1-40 Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, that enlarges the territory of
 1-41 the Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation District to
 1-42 include the territory of the Needmore Ranch Municipal Utility
 1-43 District No. 1, becomes law. If such a bill does not become law,
 1-44 this Act has no effect.
