1-15 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-16 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the right to hunt,  
 1-17 fish, and harvest wildlife.

1-18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by  
 1-20 adding Section 34 to read as follows:

1-21 Sec. 34. (a) The people have the right to hunt, fish, and  
 1-22 harvest wildlife, including by the use of traditional methods,  
 1-23 subject to laws or regulations to conserve and manage wildlife and  
 1-24 preserve the future of hunting and fishing.

1-25 (b) Hunting and fishing are preferred methods of managing  
 1-26 and controlling wildlife.

1-27 (c) This section does not affect any provision of law  
 1-28 relating to trespass, property rights, or eminent domain.

1-29 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
 1-30 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.  
 1-31 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
 1-32 proposition: "The constitutional amendment recognizing the right  
 1-33 of the people to hunt, fish, and harvest wildlife subject to laws  
 1-34 that promote wildlife conservation."
