1-19 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-20 proposing a constitutional amendment dedicating certain revenue  
 1-21 sources to be used for the acquisition of rights-of-way for and the  
 1-22 construction and maintenance of public roadways.

1-23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by  
 1-25 adding Section 7-c to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 7-c. Subject to legislative appropriation,  
 1-27 allocation, and direction, all net revenues remaining after payment  
 1-28 of all refunds allowed by law and expenses of collection derived  
 1-29 from the following sources shall be used only for the acquisition of  
 1-30 rights-of-way for and the construction and maintenance of public  
 1-31 roadways other than toll roads:

1-32 (1) fees for permits that authorize a motor vehicle or  
 1-33 combination of motor vehicles that exceed the weight or size limits  
 1-34 allowed by this state to operate on a highway in this state;

1-35 (2) payments received under a comprehensive  
 1-36 development agreement for a toll project or system of the Texas  
 1-37 Department of Transportation or its successor;

1-38 (3) the sale or transfer of any interest in a highway  
 1-39 right-of-way or real property acquired for a state highway purpose  
 1-40 that is no longer needed for a state highway purpose; and

1-41 (4) the sale of surplus motor vehicles by state  
 1-42 agencies.

1-43 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
 1-44 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.  
 1-45 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
 1-46 proposition: "The constitutional amendment dedicating certain  
 1-47 revenue sources to be used for the acquisition of rights-of-way for  
 1-48 and the construction and maintenance of public roadways."
