HB 2230 Larson / Lucio III
Relating to the authority of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to authorize an injection well used for oil and gas waste disposal to be used for the disposal of nonhazardous brine produced by a desalination operation or nonhazardous drinking water treatment residuals.

HB 675 Bonnen, Greg
Relating to the use of a mobile phone by a person occupying a voting station.

HB 39 Smithee
Relating to guardianships for incapacitated persons.

HB 1852 Naishtat / Burkett
Relating to certain assessments for children in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services.

HB 511 Moody
Relating to the prosecution of certain offenses committed against a person in custody.

HB 518 Moody
Relating to certain waivers by a defendant regarding a community supervision revocation hearing.

HB 2481 Smith
Relating to the licensing and regulation of auctioneers and associate auctioneers; amending provisions subject to a criminal penalty; requiring an occupational license; requiring a fee.

HB 2718 Parker / King, Susan / Rose
Relating to a program to allow faith- and community-based organizations to offer supplemental assistance to certain recipients of public assistance.

HB 2903 Davis, Sarah
Relating to training requirements for certain child-care workers.

HB 3327 Alvarado / Herrero / Harless / Raymond / Turner, Sylvester
Relating to a grant program to fund domestic violence high risk teams.

HB 1704 Deshotel
Relating to disclosure of pregnancy or the existence of a gestational agreement in a suit for the dissolution of a marriage and standing of an intended parent under a gestational agreement to file a suit affecting the parent-child relationship.

HB 2419 Wray
Relating to the relationship between the Estates Code and the former Texas Probate Code.

HB 1690 King, Phil / Bonnen, Dennis / Davis, Sarah / Sheets / Smithee / et al.
Relating to the prosecution of offenses against public administration, including ethics offenses.
