HB 497 Wu Relating to the applicability of the law governing saltwater pipeline facilities located in the vicinity of public roads.

HB 1286 Simmons / Moody / Dale / Villalba Relating to the prosecution and punishment of the offense of injury to a child, elderly individual, or disabled individual.

HB 904 Smith / Thompson, Senfronia / et al. Relating to the transfer of certain inmates to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice following pronouncement of the inmate's sentence.

HB 1447 Dale / Márquez / Herrero / Moody / Frullo / et al. Relating to protective orders for certain victims of sexual assault or abuse, stalking, or trafficking.

HB 2208 Herrero Relating to access to criminal history record information by a county tax assessor-collector.

HB 819 Sheffield Relating to the definition of a public health nuisance; amending provisions subject to a criminal penalty.

HB 1184 Paddie / Anchia Relating to authorizing certain utility cost savings and alternative fuel programs as eligible for local government energy savings performance contracts.

HB 372 Riddle / White, James / Murphy / Deshotel Relating to the monitoring of the Internet access of certain sex offenders placed on community supervision or released on parole or to mandatory supervision.

HB 658 Zerwas / Miller, Rick / Reynolds / Stephenson Relating to the creation of a campus of the Texas State Technical College System in Fort Bend County.

HB 225 Guillen / Johnson Relating to the prescription, administration, and possession of certain opioid antagonists for the treatment of a suspected overdose and a defense to prosecution for certain offenses involving controlled substances and other prohibited drugs, substances, or paraphernalia for defendants seeking assistance for a suspected overdose.
