**SB 18** Nelson/ Hinojosa/ Seliger/ et al. **SP:** Zerwas Relating to measures to support or enhance graduate medical education in this state, including the transfer of certain assets from the Texas Medical Liability Insurance Underwriting Association to the permanent fund supporting graduate medical education and the authority of the association to issue new policies.

**SB 24** Zaffirini/ et al. **SP:** Zerwas Relating to training for members of the governing board of a public institution of higher education.
