
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

Fact: 1 in 5 children ages 13-18 have, or will have a serious mental illness.¹









Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSA) - Mental Health HPSA Designated Type

Mental Health Needs in Rural Schools



Location of Schools


Telemedicine Wellness Intervention Triage



TWITR Outcomes

- Number of School Staff Trained = $\sim 1,610$
- Number of students impacted = $\sim 21,174$
- Number of referrals = 305
- Number screened = 114
- Number triaged = 108 (all by telemedicine)
- Number removed from school = 16
- Other outcomes = reduction in truancy (17%), reduction in student discipline referrals (25%), increase in student overall GPA (3.6%).
