## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to avoiding the abolishment of certain agencies subject to
- 3 the Texas Sunset Act on September 1, 2017.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 151.004, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.004. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas Medical
- 8 Board is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset
- 9 Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter,
- 10 the board is abolished and this subtitle and Chapters 204, 205, 206,
- 11 601, 602, 603, and 604 expire September 1, 2019 [2017].
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 501.005, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 501.005. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas State
- 15 Board of Examiners of Psychologists is subject to Chapter 325,
- 16 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence
- 17 as provided by that chapter, the board is abolished and this chapter
- 18 expires September 1, 2019 [2017].
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 502.003, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- Sec. 502.003. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas State
- 22 Board of Examiners of Marriage and Family Therapists is subject to
- 23 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued
- 24 in existence as provided by that chapter, the board is abolished and

- 1 this chapter expires September 1, 2019 [2017].
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 503.005, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 503.005. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas State
- 5 Board of Examiners of Professional Counselors is subject to Chapter
- 6 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in
- 7 existence as provided by that chapter, the board is abolished
- 8 September 1, 2019 [<del>2017</del>].
- 9 SECTION 5. Section 505.005, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 505.005. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas State
- 12 Board of Social Worker Examiners is subject to Chapter 325,
- 13 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence
- 14 as provided by that chapter, the board is abolished and Section
- 15 505.101 expires September 1, 2019 [2017].
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 21 legislative session.
