A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to pregnancy-related deaths and maternal morbidity,
3	including postpartum depression.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the Texas Moms Matter
6	Act.
7	SECTION 2. Section 34.005, Health and Safety Code, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	Sec. 34.005. DUTIES OF TASK FORCE. The task force shall:
10	(1) study, [and] review, and collect data on:
11	(A) cases of pregnancy-related deaths; [and]
12	(B) trends, rates, health conditions and
13	factors, and disparities in pregnancy-related deaths and severe
14	maternal morbidity;
15	(C) health conditions and factors that caused
16	death in the most at-risk population as determined in the Maternal
17	Mortality and Morbidity Task Force and Department of State Health
18	Services Joint Biennial Report (July 2016); and
19	(D) best practices and programs operating in
20	other states that have reduced rates of pregnancy-related deaths;
21	(2) <u>compare rates of pregnancy-related deaths based on</u>
22	the socioeconomic status of the mother;
23	(3) determine the feasibility of the task force
24	studying cases of severe maternal morbidity; and

- 1 (4) (4) (4) make recommendations to help reduce the
- 2 incidence of pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal
- 3 morbidity in this state.
- 4 SECTION 3. Sections 34.007(a) and (b), Health and Safety
- 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The department shall determine a statistically
- 7 significant number of cases of pregnancy-related deaths for review.
- 8 The department shall <u>either</u> randomly select cases <u>or select all</u>
- 9 cases for the task force to review under this subsection to reflect
- 10 a cross-section of pregnancy-related deaths in this state.
- 11 (b) The department shall <u>statistically</u> analyze aggregate
- 12 data of pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity in
- 13 this state to identify any trends, rates, or disparities.
- 14 SECTION 4. Chapter 34, Health and Safety Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Section 34.0155 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 34.0155. REPORT ON PREGNANCY-RELATED DEATHS AND
- 17 POSTPARTUM DEPRESSION. The commission shall:
- 18 (1) evaluate options for reducing pregnancy-related
- 19 deaths, focusing on the most prevalent causes of pregnancy-related
- 20 deaths as identified in the task force's biennial report required
- 21 under Section 34.015, and for treating postpartum depression in
- 22 economically disadvantaged women; and
- 23 (2) submit a written report summarizing the
- 24 commission's and department's efforts to accomplish the tasks
- 25 described by Subdivision (1) to the governor, the lieutenant
- 26 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, the
- 27 Legislative Budget Board, and the appropriate standing committees

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- 1 of the legislature not later than December 1 of each even-numbered
- 2 year.
- 3 SECTION 5. Section 34.018, Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 34.018. SUNSET PROVISION. The task force is subject to
- 6 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued
- 7 in existence as provided by that chapter, the task force is
- 8 abolished and this chapter expires September 1, 2023 [2019].
- 9 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 14 legislative session.
