Increased Access to Community Mental Health Services. 6 Included in amounts appropriated above is \$62,208,900 in General Mental D.2.1, Community Strategy in Revenue 8 Services-Adults, for the purpose of avoiding future waiting lists 9 for community mental health services provided by local mental 10 health authorities and local behavioral health authorities. 11 commission shall allocate among all local mental health authorities 12 and local behavioral health authorities amounts determined to be 13 sufficient to maintain the current capacity of those authorities, 14 to increase capacity in all local service areas, and to improve 15 equity in funding to areas with per capita funding levels that are 16 below the average by applying a funding formula that accounts for 17 the general population and the portion of the population with 18 incomes of less than 200 percent of the federal poverty level. Also 19 included in amounts appropriated above is \$464,100 in General 20 D.2.2, Community Mental Strategy in 21 Revenue Services-Children, to be allocated for the purpose of eliminating 22 the waiting list for community mental health services for children. 23 To the extent any of the amounts identified above are available after the allocations are made as prescribed by this provision, the 25 commission shall use the remainder for the purpose of eliminating 26 waiting lists for community mental health services for adults. 27
