- 2 (1) In Article II of the bill, in the appropriations for the
- 3 Department of State Health Services (page II-16), reduce the
- 4 appropriations for Strategy A.3.2, Reduce Use of Tobacco Products,
- 5 by the amount of \$4,150,000 for the state fiscal year ending August
- 6 31, 2018, and by the amount of \$4,150,000 for the state fiscal year
- 7 ending August 31, 2019.
- 8 (2) In Article III of the bill, in the appropriations for
- 9 the Texas Education Agency (page III-2), increase the
- 10 appropriations for Strategy A.2.1, Statewide Educational Programs,
- 11 by the amount of \$4,150,000 from the general revenue fund for the
- 12 state fiscal year ending August 31, 2018, and by the amount of
- 13 \$4,150,000 from the general revenue fund for the state fiscal year
- 14 ending August 31, 2019.
- 15 (3) In Article III of the bill, following the appropriations
- 16 for the Texas Education Agency (page III-3), insert the following
- 17 appropriately numbered rider:
- 18 \_\_\_\_\_. Funds for Open-Enrollment Charter School Facilities.
- 19 Out of general revenue funds appropriated above in Strategy A.2.1,
- 20 Statewide Educational Programs, the commissioner of education
- 21 shall allocate \$4,150,000 for the state fiscal year ending August
- 22 31, 2018, and \$4,150,000 for the state fiscal year ending August 31,
- 23 2019, to assist open-enrollment charter schools in purchasing,
- 24 operating, or maintaining charter school facilities.
- 25 (4) Adjust totals and methods of financing accordingly.
