- 1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) as follows:
- 2 (1) In Article III of the bill, in the appropriations to the
- 3 Higher Education Coordinating Board (page III-43), strike Strategy
- 4 E.1.3, Engineering Recruitment Program, and strike the
- 5 appropriation for that strategy for each fiscal year of the state
- 6 biennium.
- 7 (2) In Article VI of the bill, in the appropriations to the
- 8 Commission on Environmental Quality (page VI-14), reduce the
- 9 general revenue appropriations for Strategy A.1.1, Air Quality
- 10 Assessment and Planning, by the amount of \$175,000 for the state
- 11 fiscal year ending August 31, 2018, and by the amount of \$175,000
- 12 for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2019.
- 13 (3) In Article VI of the bill, following the appropriations
- 14 to the Commission on Environmental Quality, amend Rider No. 7, Air
- 15 Quality Planning, by striking "Granbury,".
- 16 (4) In Article VI of the bill, following the appropriations
- 17 to the Parks and Wildlife Department (page VI-31), add the
- 18 following appropriately numbered rider:
- 19 ___. Additional Funds for Fuels and Lubricants. In addition
- 20 to other amounts appropriated to the Parks and Wildlife Department
- 21 for the purpose of purchasing fuels and lubricants, the amount of
- 22 \$425,000 is appropriated from the general revenue fund to the
- 23 department for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2018, and the
- 24 amount of \$425,000 is appropriated from the general revenue fund to
- 25 the department for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2019, for
- 26 the purpose of purchasing fuels and lubricants.
- 27 (5) Adjust totals and methods of finance accordingly.
