HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

- 1 Amend C.S.S.B No. 1 (house committee printing) in Article
- 2 II by adding the following appropriately numbered rider.
- 3 a. Expansion of PACE Sites. The Health and Human Services
- 4 Commission (HHSC) may use funds appropriated in Strategy A.3.5,
- 5 Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) to add up
- 6 to three additional PACE sites, each serving up to 150
- 7 participants beginning in fiscal year 2018.
- 8 b. Funding for Additional Sites and Participants.
- 9 Notwithstanding HHSC, Rider 134, Transfers: Authority and
- 10 Limitations and Special Provisions Relating to All Health and
- 11 Human Services Agencies, Section 6, Limitations on Transfer
- 12 Authority, if funds appropriated in Strategy A.3.5, Program of
- 13 All-inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) are not sufficient to
- 14 pay for services described in subsection (a), the Health and
- 15 Human Services Commission (HHSC) shall transfer funds from Goal
- 16 A, Medicaid, Strategy A.1.1, Aged and Medicare-related, or
- 17 Strategy A.1.2, Disability-Related, in an amount not to exceed
- 18 \$1,784,785 in General Revenue Funds in fiscal year 2018 and
- 19 \$4,980,432 in General Revenue Funds in fiscal year 2019. The
- 20 Executive Commissioner of HHSC must certify that funds
- 21 appropriated in Strategy A.3.5, Program of All-inclusive Care
- 22 for the Elderly (PACE) were insufficient due to an increase in
- 23 the number of participants served, not due to an increase in the
- 24 average cost or rate. The Executive Commissioner of HHSC shall
- 25 provide written notification to the Legislative Budget Board and
- 26 the Governor of the certification and the transfer amounts
- 27 within 30 business days of the date on which any transfer
- 28 occurs.
- 29 c. Additional Funding for PACE Program. Should transfer





authority provided in subsection (b) be insufficient to serve 1 the increase in participants described by subsection (a), the 2 Executive Commissioner of HHSC shall submit a written request to 3 the Legislative Budget Board and the Governor for approval to 4 transfer additional funds from Strategy A.1.1, Aged 5 Medicare-related, or Strategy A.1.2, Disability-Related to 6 Strategy A.3.5, Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly 7 (PACE). The request shall be considered to be approved unless 8 the Legislative Budget Board or the Governor issues a written 9 disapproval within 30 business days of the date on which the 10 staff of the Legislative Budget Board concludes its review of 11 the request and forwards its review to the Chair of the House 12 Appropriations Committee, Chair of the Senate Finance Committee, 13 Speaker of the House, and Lieutenant Governor. Any requests for 14 additional information made by the Legislative Budget Board 15 shall interrupt the counting of the 30 business days. 16
