Registry of Persons Not Eligible for Employment in Public Schools. Out of funds appropriated above in Strategy B.3.5, Information Systems and Technology, it is the intent of the Legislature that the Texas Education Agency shall develop and maintain a registry of persons who are not eligible to be employed by a school district, district of innovation, openenrollment charter school, regional education service center, or shared service arrangement. The registry maintained under this section must list the following persons as not eligible to be employed by public schools:

- a. a person determined by the agency under Education Code Section 22.0832 as a person who would not be eligible for educator certification under Education Code Subchapter B, Chapter 21;
- a person who is not eligible for employment based on the person's criminal history record information review, as provided by Education Code Section 22.085;
- a person who is not eligible for employment based on criminal history record information received by the agency under Education Code Section 21.058(b); and
- d. a person whose certification or permit issued under Education Code Subchapter B, Chapter 21, is revoked by the State Board for Educator Certification on a finding that the person engaged in misconduct described by Education Code Section 21.006(b)(2)(A) or (A-1).
