Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 (house committee report) in Article V of the bill, following the appropriations to the Juvenile Justice Department (page V-35), by adding the following appropriately numbered rider:

Transfer of Appropriations Contingent on H.B. 122 or Similar Legislation. Contingent on H.B. 122 or similar legislation of the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, relating to the age of criminal responsibility and to certain substantive and procedural matters related to that age becoming law, and notwithstanding any limitation on the transfer or use of appropriated money provided by this Act, for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2018, the Trusteed Programs Within the Office of the Governor shall transfer \$7,500,000 to the Juvenile Justice Department for that year for the purpose of funding the cost to the Juvenile Justice Department of housing an increased number of juveniles in detention facilities following the passage of H.B. 122 or similar legislation. The Juvenile Justice Department shall use money transferred under this section to reimburse local juvenile probation departments for expenses incurred incident to the increased number of juveniles served by those departments. Money transferred under this rider shall come from the Trusteed Programs Within the Office of the Governor Strategy B.1.1, Criminal Justice (page I-50).
