1 Amend S.B. No. 319 (house committee report) by adding the 2 following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly: 3 SECTION ____. Section 801.004, Occupations Code, is amended 4 to read as follows: 5 6 Sec. 801.004. APPLICATION OF CHAPTER. This chapter does not apply to: 7 (1) the treatment or care of an animal in any manner by 8 the owner of the animal, an employee of the owner, or a designated 9 caretaker of the animal, unless the ownership, employment, or 10 11 designation is established with the intent to violate this chapter; (2) a person who performs an act prescribed by the 12 board as an accepted livestock management practice, including: 13 14 (A) castrating a male animal raised for human consumption; 15 docking or earmarking an animal raised for 16 (B) 17 human consumption; dehorning cattle; (C) 18 (D) aiding in the nonsurgical birth process of a 19 20 large animal, as defined by board rule; (E) treating an animal for disease prevention 21 with a nonprescription medicine or vaccine; 22 (F) branding or identifying an animal in any 23 manner; 24 (G) artificially inseminating 25 including training, inseminating, and compensating for services 26 related to artificial insemination; and 27 (H) shoeing a horse; 28 (3) the performance of a cosmetic or production 29

- 3 (4) the performance of a duty by a veterinarian's
- 4 employee if:
- 5 (A) the duty involves food production animals;
- 6 (B) the duty does not involve diagnosis,
- 7 prescription, or surgery;
- 8 (C) the employee is under the direction and
- 9 general supervision of the veterinarian; and
- 10 (D) the veterinarian is responsible for the
- 11 employee's performance;
- 12 (5) the performance of an act by a person who is a
- 13 full-time student of an accredited college of veterinary medicine
- 14 if the act is performed under the direct supervision of a
- 15 veterinarian;
- 16 (6) an animal shelter employee who performs euthanasia
- 17 in the course and scope of the person's employment if the person has
- 18 successfully completed training in accordance with Chapter 829,
- 19 Health and Safety Code;
- 20 (7) a person who is engaged in a recognized
- 21 state-federal cooperative disease eradication or control program
- 22 or an external parasite control program while the person is
- 23 performing official duties required by the program;
- 24 (8) a person who, without expectation of compensation,
- 25 provides emergency care in an emergency or disaster; [ox]
- 26 (9) a consultation given to a veterinarian in this
- 27 state by a person who:
- 28 (A) resides in another state; and
- 29 (B) is lawfully qualified to practice veterinary
- 30 medicine under the laws of that state; or
- 31 (10) a licensed health care professional who, without

- 1 expectation of compensation and under the direct supervision of a
- 2 <u>veterinarian</u>, provides treatment or care to an animal owned by or in
- 3 the possession, control, or custody of an entity accredited by the
- 4 Association of Zoos and Aquariums.
