- 2 relating to the sale of fireworks on and before the Juneteenth 3 holiday.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 2154.202(g), Occupations 5 is
- amended to read as follows: 6
- 7 Except as provided by Subsection (h), a retail fireworks
- permit holder may sell fireworks only to the public, and only during 8
- 9 periods:
- beginning June 14 and ending at midnight on June 10 (1)
- 19; 11

- beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4; 12 (2)
- 13 (3) $[\frac{(2)}{(2)}]$ beginning December 20 and ending at midnight
- 14 on January 1 of the following year; and
- (4) $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$ beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on 15
- May 5 if the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 16
- 100 miles from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in 17
- which the commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of 18
- fireworks during the period. 19
- SECTION 2. Section 352.051(b)(1), Local Government Code, is 20
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (1)The Texas A&M Forest Service in the ordinary
- 23 COURSE of its activities shall determine whether drought
- conditions, as defined under Subsection (a)(2), exist on average in 2.4

- 1 any county requesting such a determination. The Texas $\underline{A\&M}$ Forest
- 2 Service shall make available the measurement index guidelines used
- 3 to determine whether drought conditions exist in a particular area.
- 4 Following any determination that such drought conditions exist, the
- 5 Texas A&M Forest Service shall notify said county or counties when
- 6 such drought conditions no longer exist. The Texas A&M Forest
- 7 Service shall make its services available each day during the Texas
- 8 Independence Day, San Jacinto Day, Memorial Day, <u>Juneteenth</u>, Fourth
- 9 of July, and December fireworks seasons to respond to the request of
- 10 any county for a determination whether drought conditions exist on
- 11 average in the county.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 352.051(d), Local Government Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (d) To facilitate compliance with an order adopted under
- 15 Subsection (c), the order must be adopted before:
- 16 (1) February 15 of each year for the Texas
- 17 Independence Day fireworks season;
- 18 (2) April 1 of each year for the San Jacinto Day
- 19 fireworks season;
- 20 (3) April 25 of each year for the Cinco de Mayo
- 21 fireworks season;
- 22 (4) May 15 of each year for the Memorial Day fireworks
- 23 season;
- 24 (5) June 1 of each year for the Juneteenth fireworks
- 25 season;
- 26 (6) June 15 of each year for the Fourth of July
- 27 fireworks season; and

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- 1 (7) [(6)] December 15 of each year for each December
- 2 fireworks season.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
