 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to public outreach materials to foster awareness of  
 1-22 certain public school curriculum requirements.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Sections 28.015(b) and (c), Education Code, are  
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (b) The materials developed under this section must:

1-27 (1) be available in English, Spanish, and Vietnamese;

1-28 (2) be in a form that would allow school districts to  
 1-29 mail the information to students and parents; and

1-30 (3) include an explanation of:

1-31 (A) the basic career and college readiness  
 1-32 components of each endorsement under Section 28.025(c-1);

1-33 (B) the curriculum requirements to gain  
 1-34 automatic college admission under Section 51.803; and

1-35 (C) applicable course, graduation plan, and  
 1-36 endorsement requirements for financial aid authorized under Title  
 1-37 3, including curriculum requirements for:

1-38 (i) the TEXAS grant as provided under  
 1-39 Subchapter M, Chapter 56; and

1-40 (ii) the Texas Educational Opportunity  
 1-41 Grant Program as provided under Subchapter P, Chapter 56; and

1-42 ~~[(iii) the Texas B-On-time loan program as  
 1-43 provided under Subchapter Q, Chapter 56].~~

1-44 (c) This section expires September 1, 2020 [2018].

1-45 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-46 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-47 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-48 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-49 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
