 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the issuance of specialty license plates to surviving
 1-18 spouses of certain military veterans.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 504.302, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-21 by adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (b) to read as
 1-22 follows:

1-23 (a-1) The surviving spouse of a person who would be eligible
 1-24 for a specialty license plate under Section 504.308, 504.310,
 1-25 504.315, 504.316, or 504.319 is entitled to register one vehicle
 1-26 under the applicable section as long as the spouse remains
 1-27 unmarried.

1-28 (b) An applicant [~~for registration~~] under this section must
 1-29 submit proof of the eligibility of the applicant's deceased spouse
 1-30 for the applicable specialty license plate.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
