1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 1001.055(a), Education Code, is amended
 1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (a) The department shall provide to each licensed or exempt
 1-25 driver education school and to each parent-taught course provider
 1-26 approved under this chapter driver education certificates or
 1-27 certificate numbers to enable the school or approved parent-taught
 1-28 course provider to print and issue department-approved driver
 1-29 education certificates to certify completion of an approved driver
 1-30 education course and satisfy the requirements of Sections [521.1601](#)
 1-31 and [521.204](#)(a)(2), Transportation Code [~~, [521.1601](#), Transportation~~
 1-32 ~~Code, as added by Chapter 1253 (H.B. 339), Acts of the 81st~~
 1-33 ~~Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, and [521.1601](#), Transportation~~
 1-34 ~~Code, as added by Chapter 1413 (S.B. 1317), Acts of the 81st~~
 1-35 ~~Legislature, Regular Session, 2009]~~.

1-36 SECTION 2. Section [521.142](#)(d), Transportation Code, as
 1-37 amended by Chapters 1253 (H.B. 339) and 1413 (S.B. 1317), Acts of
 1-38 the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted to read
 1-39 as follows:

1-40 (d) If the applicant is under 25 years of age, the
 1-41 application must state whether the applicant has completed a driver
 1-42 education course required by Section [521.1601](#).

1-43 SECTION 3. Section [521.1601](#), Transportation Code, as added
 1-44 by Chapter 1253 (H.B. 339), Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular
 1-45 Session, 2009, is repealed.

1-46 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
