- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 411.175, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 411.175. PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITTING FINGERPRINTS. The
- 9 department shall establish procedures for the submission of legible
- 10 and classifiable fingerprints by an applicant for a license under
- 11 this subchapter who:
- 12 (1) is required to submit those fingerprints to the
- 13 department, including an applicant under Section 411.199,
- 14 411.1991, 411.1992, 411.1993, or 411.201; and
- 15 (2) resides in a county having a population of 46,000
- 16 or less and does not reside within a 25-mile radius of a facility
- 17 with the capability to process digital or electronic fingerprints.
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 19 amended by amending Section 411.1991 and adding Section 411.1993 to
- 20 read as follows:
- Sec. 411.1991. PEACE OFFICERS. (a) A person who is
- 22 licensed as a peace officer under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code,
- 23 and employed as a peace officer by a law enforcement agency[, or who
- 24 is a member of the Texas military forces, excluding Texas State

- 1 Guard members who are serving in the Texas Legislature, apply
- 2 for a license under this subchapter.
- 3 (b) $[\frac{(a-1)}{a-1}]$ An applicant who is a peace officer shall submit
- 4 to the department:
- 5 (1) the name and rank of the applicant; and
- 6 (2) a current copy of the applicant's peace officer
- 7 license and evidence of employment as a peace officer.
- 8 (c) The department may issue a license under this subchapter
- 9 to an applicant under this section if the applicant complies with
- 10 Subsection (b) and meets all other requirements of this subchapter,
- 11 except that the applicant is not required to complete the handgun
- 12 proficiency course described by Section 411.188.
- 13 (d) The department shall waive any fee required for the
- 14 issuance of an original, duplicate, modified, or renewed license
- 15 under this subchapter for an applicant under this section.
- 16 <u>(e) A license issued to an applicant under this section</u>
- 17 expires as provided by Section 411.183.
- 18 Sec. 411.1993. CERTAIN MEMBERS OF TEXAS MILITARY FORCES.
- 19 (a) A person who is a member of the Texas military forces, other
- 20 than a member of the Texas State Guard who is serving in the Texas
- 21 Legislature, may apply for a license under this subchapter.
- (b) $[\frac{(a-2)}{a-2}]$ The department shall adopt rules regarding the
- 23 information required to be included in an application submitted by
- 24 a member of the Texas military forces under this section.
- 25 $\underline{\text{(c)}}$ [\frac{\text{(b)}}{}] The department may issue a license under this
- 26 subchapter to an applicant under this section if the applicant
- 27 complies with the [Subsection (a-1) or] rules adopted under

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- 1 Subsection (b) [(a-2), as applicable].
- (d) (d) An applicant under this section shall pay a fee of
- 3 \$25 for a license issued under this subchapter.
- 4 (e) $(\frac{d}{d})$ A license issued to an applicant under this
- 5 section expires as provided by Section 411.183.
- 6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to an application that is made to obtain an original, duplicate,
- 8 modified, or renewed license to carry a handgun and submitted on or
- 9 after the effective date of this Act. An application described by
- 10 this section that is submitted before the effective date of this Act
- 11 is governed by the law in effect when the application was submitted,
- 12 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
